From autumn 2001 the Bachelor Degree Program in Real Estate Studies replaced the former Associate Degree Program in Real Estate Studies. Students who have attended the former Associate Degree Program are required to pass all written exams, 120 credits before sitting for the oral exam. Students attending the Bachelor Program are required to pass all written exams, 165 credits, and in addition they must have handed in Bachelor thesis in Real Estate, 15 credits before sitting for the oral exam.

The exam takes place at the end of the semester. The oral exam may include questions from all subject areas. Even if a student has been granted a waiver on a course in the second year he/she may still be asked questions from this subject at the oral exam.
