From autumn 2001 the Bachelor Degree Program in Real Estate Studies replaced the former Associate Degree Program in Real Estate Studies. Students attending the Bachelor Program are required to pass all written exams, 165 credits, and in addition they must have handed in Bachelor thesis in Real Estate, 15 credits before sitting for the oral exam.
